1 Scope

GB 19079.22-2013 is the Chinese national standard on operation conditions and technical requirements for gymnasium and playground-part 22 : taekwondo venue, in the field of domestic and commercial equipment, entertainment, sport. It carries no /T suffix, which in the Chinese system means compliance is mandatory: a product or a practice within its scope has to meet it to be lawfully made, sold or carried out in China. It was issued on 31

December 2013 by the General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine of the People's Republic of China; Standardization Administration of China, and has been in force since 1 December 2014. Classification: ICS 97.220, CCS Y55. This page is published from the official record of the standard held by the Chinese standards administration: the identification, the dates, the classification and the issuing body are taken from there. The clause text, the tables and the numeric limits are in the document itself, which is delivered complete in English translation.

3 Terms and Definitions

The following terms and definitions apply to this document.

3.1 Taekwondo places taekwondovenue Place to meet people to taekwondo training, competition, fitness and leisure activities.

3.2 Taekwondo technical guidance personnel taekwondoinstructor Taekwondo teach theory and skills of staff.

4 Qualifying

Tae Kwon Do instructors should hold the relevant national vocational qualification certificate before taking. 5 places, facilities and conditions

5.1 Taekwondo places use area should not be less than 100m², and a width of not less than 8m.

5.2 taekwondo taekwondo mat should be laid floor spaces, all spaces within the fixed projections, sharp edges, acute angles, etc. should be protective measures.

5.3 Taekwondo place from the ground should not have obstacles within 2.5m, the illumination shall be not less than 100lx.

5.4 Taekwondo sites should have a dressing room.

5.5 taekwondo places entrance and dressing room should identify the public, and in line

with GB/T 10001.1 requirements.

5.6 Training and protective equipment should be made of product quality inspection certificate. 6 health, environmental management Taekwondo places should be ventilated to protect the indoor and outdoor air convection.

7 Security

7.1 should establish and improve the safe production responsibility system for posts, rescue and safety management system, equipment and facilities maintenance system, environmental management and health And other systems.

7.2 should develop emergency response plans.

7.3 should be labeled "taekwondo places Precautions" in the apparent position of safety-related issues and special requirements to make real clear instructions and warnings.

7.4 During open venues per capita area of not less than 4m².

7.5 taekwondo taekwondo places should be not less than one technical guidance personnel, mentors and public directory, and photo prominently. open Each taekwondo instructor during technical guidance at the same time the number should not exceed 30 people.

7.6 confrontation training, trainers should ensure Wear protective gear taekwondo training and supplies.

7.7 Taekwondo places employees induction should wear clearly marked.

7.8 emergency exit and evacuation routes should be identified and kept clear.
