1 Scope

GB 26529-2011 is the Chinese national standard on safety specification on censoring for religious activities and tourism venues, in the field of environment and health protection, safety. It carries no /T suffix, which in the Chinese system means compliance is mandatory: a product or a practice within its scope has to meet it to be lawfully made, sold or carried out in China. It was issued on 12 May 2011 by the General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine of the People's Republic of China; Standardization Administration of China, and has been in force since 1 October 2011. This standard specifies the basic requirements for places of religious activity and tourism venues incense security, safety management and training and advocacy. This standard applies to safety management have incense burning incense active sites for religious activities and tourist sites.

3 Terms and Definitions

The following terms and definitions apply to this document.

3.1 Incense activity censingactivity Lit incense in religious activities and tourism venues, candle, oil activities.

4 Basic requirements

4.1 sites for religious activities and tourism venues shall have a safety management system and burning incense with security managers.

4.2 furnace incense, incense kiosks point should be provided in the hall outside the more open areas.

4.3 Burning incense set points should be separated from the storage site.

4.4 sites for religious activities and tourism venues offer incense products should comply with GB 26386 incense products general technical requirements.

4.5 civilizations should set Incense and environmental protection boot identity in religious activities and tourist places of incense point, not every time the number of pilgrimage More than three.

4.6 sites for religious activities and tourist sites should be set incense security, fire and other warning signs.

4.7 sites for religious activities and tourist sites should be national standards, industry standards equipped with appropriate fire-fighting facilities and equipment.

4.8 sites for religious activities and tourist sites should be held at least once every six months fire safety drills.

5 Security Management

5.1 Security Management System Sites for religious activities and tourism venues should carry burning incense safety management, the main contents include.

a) burning incense organizations to develop a safety management system;

Note. The conditions may include burning incense point, set point memory, number and size, inspection and processing of specific time and frequency, the management of business processes and operating regulations Fan and so on.

- b) clearly incense security officer job responsibilities;
- c) the development of safety management contingency plans for burning incense;
- d) Establish incense security incident reporting system and so on.

5.2 Security Duties Religious activities and responsibilities of the main tourist sites security officer shall include.

- a) prompt believers and tourists civilized and orderly pilgrimage to guide the masses of believers and tourists selected in line with GB 26386 incense products through With the technical requirements of incense products;
- b) promptly clean fragrant head, and safe handling, eliminate fire hazards;
- c) regular inspection, repair and maintenance of facilities and equipment to ensure running well;
- d) is responsible for the jurisdiction of fire safety in the region, especially in fixed source of fire safety for burning incense;
- e) When the wind reached or more than four or weather remained dry, it should be strengthened to the point of burning incense inspection and cleaning, if necessary, stop burning incense activity;
- f) When the number of the number of participants received security event than burning incense sites for religious activities and tourism venues set, restrictions should be taken into The timely and effective counseling and other measures.

5.3 Safety Management major events

5.3.1 before major events, should meet the following requirements.

- a) develop specific implementation measures in accordance with the work program and incense security contingency plans;
- b) a comprehensive inspection of fire safety equipment and other facilities to ensure that equipment and facilities are in good condition;
- c) Enhanced security management personnel, and to identify major issues and activities of the key persons responsible for security matters, a clear mandate;
- d) conduct safety drills.

5.3.2 major events, should meet the following requirements.

- a) to strengthen the point of burning incense site guidance and supervision;
- b) When the number of excessive burning of incense, should be cleaned to eliminate burning incense, burning incense kiosks and other points of fire;
- c) for major events in real-time monitoring of key points, identify problems and take timely remedial measures to activate contingency plans if necessary.

6 training and information

6.1 sites for religious activities and tourist sites should be regularly for staff safety training, the training should include.

- a) burning incense and safety management laws and regulations;
- b) staff job responsibilities;
- c) basic firefighting knowledge and skills;
