Personal protective equipment, also known as labor protection equipment, is the "last line of defense" to protect the lives of hundreds of millions of workers: Practitioners are correct Wearing and using personal protective equipment is an important means to ensure safe production and emergency management in my country: Establish mandatory personal protective equipment The equipment standards are to specify and standardize the requirements of Article 45 of the "Work Safety Law of the People's Republic of China": GB 39800 "Individual Defense "Personal Protective Equipment Equipment Specifications" aims to establish the requirements for the equipment and management of personal protective equipment for employers, and is intended to consist of the following ten parts:

---Part 1: General principles: The purpose is to establish the overall requirements for the employer's personal protective equipment equipment, including equipment principles, equipment Process, identification and assessment of hazardous factors in the workplace, selection, discarding and replacement of personal protective equipment, training and use, etc:

---Part 2: Petroleum, chemical industry, natural gas: The purpose is to establish personal protective equipment for employers in the petroleum, chemical and natural gas industries Equipment requirements, identification and assessment of hazard factors, etc:

---Part 3: Metallurgy, non-ferrous metals: The purpose is to establish the personal protective equipment requirements and hazard causes for employers in the metallurgical and non-ferrous metal industries: Identification and evaluation of elements, etc:

---Part 4: Non-coal mines: The purpose is to establish the personal protective equipment requirements and hazard factors for employers in non-coal mining industries: identification and evaluation, etc:

---Part 5: Building materials: The purpose is to establish requirements for personal protective equipment for employers in the building materials industry, identification of hazard factors and Assessment etc:

1 Scope

GB 39800.6-2023 is the Chinese national standard on specifications for the provision of personal protective equipment - part 6: electric power industry, in the field of environment and health protection, safety. It carries no /T suffix, which in the Chinese system means compliance is mandatory: a product or a practice within its scope has to meet it to be lawfully made, sold or carried out in China. It was issued on 28 December 2023 by the State Administration for Market Regulation; Standardization Administration of China, and has been in force since 1 January 2025. Classification: ICS 13.340.01, CCS C73. This page is published from the official record of the standard held by the Chinese standards administration: the identification, the dates, the classification and the issuing body are taken from there. Employers should combine the characteristics of safe production in the power industry and comply with the requirements of 4:2 in GB 39800:1-2020 during their production processes: Identify and assess hazards that may be involved: Employers can refer to the job categories listed in Table 1, or refer to those listed in Appendix A: Identify hazard factors for the type of work and conduct a hazard assessment on the identified hazard factors as a basis for selecting appropriate personal protective equipment: in accordance with:
