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Foreword

GB/T 10001 "Public Information Graphical Symbols" is divided into general symbols and symbols in specific fields according to the field of application. It is proposed to be divided into the following section.

- 1.General symbols;
- 2.Tourism and leisure symbols;
- 3.Passenger and cargo symbols;
- 4.Sports and fitness symbols;
- 5.Shopping symbols;
- 6.Medical care symbols;
- 7.Office teaching symbols;
- 8.Behavior indicators;
- 9.Symbols for barrier-free facilities;
- 10.Common symbol elements. This part is Part 9 of GB/T 10001. This section is drafted in accordance with the rules given in GB/T 1.1-2009 "Guidelines for Standardization Part 1.Standard Structure and Compilation". This part replaces GB/T 10001.9-2008 "Public Information Graphic Symbols for Signs Part 9.Symbols for Barrier-Free Facilities", and Compared with GB/T 10001.9-2008, the main technical changes are as follows:

a) Add 11 graphic symbols. barrier-free lift, barrier-free counter, barrier-free shower, hearing aid circuit, assistive dog, blind, elderly Priority for people, priority for disabled, priority for pregnant women, priority for people with infants, priority for people with medical devices in

their bodies;

1 Scope

GB/T 10001.9-2021 is the Chinese national standard on public information graphical symbols - part 9: symbols for accessible facilities, in the field of generalities, terminology and documentation. The /T suffix marks it as a recommended standard: it is not compulsory by itself, but it becomes binding as soon as a contract, a tender or a customer specification calls it up - which in practice is how most foreign buyers meet it. It was issued on 9 March 2021 by the State Administration for Market Regulation; Standardization Administration of China, and has been in force since 1 October 2021. Classification: ICS 01.080.10, CCS A22. This page is published from the official record of the standard held by the Chinese standards administration: the identification, the dates, the classification and the issuing body are taken from there. The clause text, the tables and the numeric limits are in the document itself, which is delivered complete in English translation.

This part of GB/T 10001 defines barrier-free devices for the disabled, the elderly, the injured and other people with special needs. The public information graphic symbols (hereinafter referred to as graphic symbols) implemented by the implementation of the graphic symbols give the meaning and description of the graphic symbols, and stipulate the relevant applications Claim. This part is applicable to airports, railway stations, bus stations, ports, urban rail transit stations, transportation vehicles, hotels, restaurants, parks, tourist attractions, and tourist attractions. Tourist attractions, various sports venues, fitness and entertainment centers, shopping malls, shopping centers, supermarkets, hospitals, emergency centers, health centers, physical examination centers, offices Public places and related facilities such as buildings, office buildings, schools, etc., are specifically used for location signs, guidance signs, and information requests in the public information guidance system. The design of guiding elements in guiding signs, schematic diagrams, block diagrams, portable prints and other information carriers.

5 Application

5.1 This part should be used in conjunction with GB/T 10001.1. In application, if other graphic symbols are needed, the other graphic symbols in GB/T 10001 should be used. Select from the remaining part.

5.2 If you need to design a new graphic symbol, it should be designed in accordance with the requirements of GB/T 16903, and should be designed in accordance with GB/T 16900.2 and GB/T 16903.31) requirements for testing. 1) This standard is proposed to be revised and renumbered as GB/T 16900.3.

5.3 The subscripts in the graphic symbol column of Table 1 do not constitute an integral part of the graphic symbols, but are only the basis for defining the symbol area. In design-oriented In the case of prime, the graphic symbols (including the subscripts) in Table 1 should be enlarged or reduced in equal proportions, and the position of the graphic symbols should be determined based on the subscripts.
