1 Scope

GB/T 10346-2023 is the Chinese national standard on general principle of inspection and sign, packaging, transport, storage for baijiu, in the field of food technology. The /T suffix marks it as a recommended standard: it is not compulsory by itself, but it becomes binding as soon as a contract, a tender or a customer specification calls it up - which in practice is how most foreign buyers meet it. It was issued on 7 September 2023 by the State Administration for Market Regulation; Standardization Administration of China, and has been in force since 1 October 2024. Classification: ICS 67.160.10, CCS X61. This page is published from the official record of the standard held by the Chinese standards administration: the identification, the dates, the classification and the issuing body are taken from there. 3 Terms and definitions

The following terms and definitions apply to this document.

3.1 Baijiu Baijiu It uses grains as the main raw materials, Daqu, Xiaoqu, bran koji, enzyme preparations and yeast as saccharification starter. After cooking, saccharification, fermentation, distillation, Distilled liquor made from aging and blending. [Source: GB/T 15109-2021,3.5.1]

4 Inspection rules

4.1 Batch grouping Products with the same formula, quality, variety, specification, and packaging are considered to be a batch.

4.2 Sampling

4.2.1 In the finished product warehouse or packaging production line, samples of the same batch of products shall be randomly selected according to Table

1. When sampling in the packaging production line, samples shall be taken according to Sampling is carried out at intervals according to the batch number of boxes in the production plan.

4.2.2 When the total sampling volume is less than 2.0L, the sampling volume should be increased proportionally to 2.0L; the net content of a single package is greater than or equal to 2.0L At this time, a unit sample (bottle, jar, etc.) can be randomly selected from the same batch of products.

4.2.3 Both supply and demand parties may also formulate sampling plans in accordance with the provisions of GB/T 30642.
