1 Scope

GB/T 11800-2008 is the Chinese national standard on marine explosion-proof type axial flow fans, in the field of shipbuilding and marine structures. The /T suffix marks it as a recommended standard: it is not compulsory by itself, but it becomes binding as soon as a contract, a tender or a customer specification calls it up - which in practice is how most foreign buyers meet it. It was issued on 3 March 2008 by the General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine of the People's Republic of China; Standardization Administration of China, and has been in force since 1 September 2008. Classification: ICS 47.020.50, CCS U47. This standard specifies a single stage, single suction Marine explosion-proof axial fan (hereinafter referred to as the "explosion-proof fan") product classifications, requirements, test side Method, inspection rules, marking, packaging, transportation and storage. This standard applies to explosion-proof ventilation fan design, production, testing and acceptance.
