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Foreword

This standard replaces GB/T 13832-1992 "Angora Rabbit rabbit." This standard compared with GB/T 13832-1992 main changes are as follows:

1 Scope

GB/T 13832-2009 is the Chinese national standard on angora rabbit hair, in the field of textile and leather technology. The /T suffix marks it as a recommended standard: it is not compulsory by itself, but it becomes binding as soon as a contract, a tender or a customer specification calls it up - which in practice is how most foreign buyers meet it. It was issued on 23 April 2009 by the General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine of the People's Republic of China; Standardization Administration of China, and has been in force since 1 September 2009. Classification: ICS 59.060.01, CCS W20. This page is published from the official record of the standard held by the Chinese standards administration: the identification, the dates, the classification and the issuing body are taken from there. The clause text, the tables and the numeric limits are in the document itself, which is delivered complete in English translation.

3 Terms and Definitions

The following terms and definitions apply to this standard.

- 3.1 Hair obtained from Angora rabbit (Angora rabbit) body.
- 3.2 Diameter greater than or equal $30\mu\text{m}$, and there are two or more myeloid without hair curly fur fibers.
- 3.3 Diameter of less than $30\mu\text{m}$ rabbit hair fibers.
- 3.4 On one fiber, both coarse and fine wool rabbit hair fiber characteristics.
- 3.5 In each group, the number of fibers for the right average fiber length value.
- 3.6 Total fiber length less than or equal the number of rabbit 20mm root divided by the total number of samples, expressed as a percentage.
