1 Scope

This document specifies the product classification, technical requirements, inspection rules, packaging, marking, transportation, storage, and describes the test methods of Yuecai porcelain.

This document applies to the production, inspection, and sales of Guangdong colored porcelain products. Other Guangdong colored porcelain products may also be used for reference.

This document does not apply to handmade intangible cultural heritage products.

3 Terms and Definitions

The terms and definitions defined in GB/T 3303, GB/T 5000 and the following apply to this document.

3.1 Guangdong decoration; cantonese painting

The traditional overglaze painting decoration technique of Guangdong ceramics.

Note. It includes Guangcai in Guangzhou and Chaocai in Chaoshan. It includes techniques such as drawing, coloring, dyeing, printing, pasting, filling, piling, spraying, and etching. It likes to use gold as the base, piling gold, drawing, and so on.

Gold and brightly colored materials are often used. The lines of the picture are three-dimensional and the colors are bright, giving a sense of splendor and splendor.

4 Product Categories

4.1 According to the purpose of the product, it is divided into decorative art porcelain and daily use porcelain.

4.2 According to product specifications, they are divided into small, medium, large and special types. The specification range is shown in Table 1.

4.3 Products are divided into superior products, first-class products and qualified products according to their appearance quality.
