GB/T 15310 drafted in accordance with this part of GB/T 1.1-2009 given rules. This Part replaces GB/T 15310.4-1994. Compared with GB/T 15310.4-1994, the main changes are as follows:

- The original standard name of "People's Republic of China's foreign trade export documents - export certificate of origin" to "Chinese people People's Republic of exports of goods certificate of origin form ";
- GB/T 15310.1, GB/T 15310.2, and GB/T 15310.3 are business documents, and the People's Republic of China export goods Certificate of Origin was a government document, the document does not belong to the same class, so the name made major changes;
- Delete the original standard in Appendix A, will be included in appendix A of Chapter 4 of this standard;
- Redesign of the People's Republic of China exports of goods origin certificate;
- The re-format has been described. This part of the National Standardization Technical Committee on Electronic Business (SAC/TC83) and focal points. The /T suffix marks it as a recommended standard: it is not compulsory by itself, but it becomes binding as soon as a contract, a tender or a customer specification calls it up - which in practice is how most foreign buyers meet it. It was issued on 31 December 2012 by the General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine of the People's Republic of China; Standardization Administration of China, and has been in force since 1 June 2013. Classification: ICS 01.140.30, CCS A13. This page is published from the official record of the standard held by the Chinese standards administration: the identification, the dates, the classification and the issuing body are taken from there. The clause text, the tables and the numeric limits are in the document itself, which is delivered complete in English translation.
