This standard replaces GB/T 15315-1994 "Notice to Mariners preparation of specifications." Compared with the standard GB/T 15315-1994 The main changes are as follows:

- Increased Notices to Mariners release form (see Chapter 4);
- Refine and improve the content published Notices to Mariners (1994 version 3.4, this version 4.4);
- Amend the relevant provisions of the coordinate system used (1994 version 3.6, this version 4.5.1);
- Deleted the provisions relating to digital annotation (1994 version 3.9), an increase of units of measurement and the accuracy of the content (see Chapter 4);
- Revised Notice to Mariners content arrangement, increasing the navigation information, books, message content (the 1994 edition of 3.8.2.1, this edition 4.8);
- Increased use of Geographical Names principle (see Chapter 4);
- Refine the details of the preparation of the content, to further clarify the method of preparation of the title of the notice of item numbers, place names and other content and tips to Seeking to modify the contents of the notice to correct the form of a note (the 1994 edition of Chapter 6, Chapter 7 of this edition);

- Remove map corrections on the contents (1994 Version 6.5.7);
 - Revised appendix describes the style (the 1994 edition of Appendix C, this edition of Appendix E);
 - Increase the informative Appendix "Information prepared nautical style" (Appendix F);
 - Increase the informative Appendix "written in the style correction chart" (Appendix J).

1 Scope

GB/T 15315-2008 is the Chinese national standard on specifications for notices to mariners, in the field of services and company organization. The /T suffix marks it as a recommended standard: it is not compulsory by itself, but it becomes binding as soon as a contract, a tender or a customer specification calls it up - which in practice is how most foreign buyers meet it. It was issued on 20 June 2008 by the General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine of the People's Republic of China; Standardization Administration of China, and has been in force since 1 December 2008. Classification: ICS 03.220.40, CCS R61. 3 Terms and Definitions
