This part replaces GB/T 15566.3-2007 "Principles and Requirements of Public Information Guidance System Part 3.Railway Passenger Stations", Compared with GB/T 15566.3-2007, the main technical changes are as follows:

1 Scope

GB/T 15566.3-2020 is the Chinese national standard on public information guidance systems - setting principles and requirements - part 3: railway passenger station, in the field of generalities, terminology and documentation. The /T suffix marks it as a recommended standard: it is not compulsory by itself, but it becomes binding as soon as a contract, a tender or a customer specification calls it up - which in practice is how most foreign buyers meet it. It was issued on 31 March 2020 by the State Administration for Market Regulation; Standardization Administration of China, and has been in force since 1 October 2020.

The clause text, the tables and the numeric limits are in the document itself, which is delivered complete in English translation.

This part of GB/T 15566 specifies the composition and installation of the public information guidance system of railway passenger stations (referred to as the station guidance system) Principles and setting requirements, as well as the coordination requirements between the station guidance system and other guidance systems, and the evaluation requirements of the station guidance system. This part is applicable to the installation of public information guidance system mainly composed of static signs in railway passenger stations.

3 Terms and definitions

The terms and definitions defined in GB/T 15565 and GB/T 13317 apply to this document.

4 The composition of the guidance system

4.1 Sub-guide system According to the passenger's activity route and activity area, the station guidance system can be divided into the following interrelated sub-guidance systems.

- Passenger guidance system in the square in front of the station;
- Station building passenger guidance system;
- Platform passenger guidance system;
- Parking lot passenger guidance system.

4.2 Guiding elements The station guidance system can be composed of one or more of the following guidance elements.

- Location sign;
- Orientation signs;
- Information index sign;
- Schematic plan view;
- Block orientation map;
- Portable printed matter.

5 General principles and requirements

5.1 The planning and design of the station guidance system should conform to the principles and methods specified in GB/T 38654. The station guidance system should be set up to meet the principles and requirements specified in GB/T 15566.1. The design of the guiding elements in the station guiding system should meet the requirements of GB/T 20501.

5.2 The text used in the guidance system of a railway passenger station located at the national border (port) or a railway passenger station with entry and exit trains Chinese and English should be used at the same time, and other types of text can be added as needed. English translation should meet the relevant requirements of GB/T 30240.

5.3 Railway passenger stations in ethnic autonomous regions should use Chinese and local ethnic languages in accordance with relevant laws and regulations in ethnic autonomous regions.

5.4 The guidance information that should be provided by the station guidance system includes guidance information that directly serves passengers waiting, boarding and landing, and other service places. Or guide information for service equipment and facilities.

Note. Other common service places or service equipment facilities in railway passenger stations include but are not limited to: small pieces storage, information desk, medical point, toilet (including Barrier-free toilets), washrooms, drinking places, alarm points, public telephones, ATMs, currency exchange offices, shops, restaurants, entertainment facilities, parking lots, etc.

5.5 The station guidance system should fully consider the provision of barrier-free guidance information, and the design and setting of barrier-free guidance elements should conform to the relevant requirements of GB/T 31015.

5.6 The station guidance system should be set up to guide the passengers of other public transportation facilities in the city, such as adjacent coach stations and public transportation stations. The systems connect and coordinate with each other.

Note. The public transport stations in this section include public trams, buses, taxis, subways, light rails and other public transport stations in the city.

5.7 When road traffic signs need to be set on the roads connected to railway passenger stations, the road traffic signs and their settings should meet the relevant requirements of GB 5768.

5.8 Guide information with fixed information content in railway passenger stations should be provided using static signs, and the information content changes dynamically or the amount of information. Larger directional information should be provided by means of dynamic display.

5.9 On the premise of meeting the passenger-oriented demand, it is advisable to set an
