1 Scope

GB/T 15781-2015 is the Chinese national standard on regulations for forest tending, in the field of food technology. The /T suffix marks it as a recommended standard: it is not compulsory by itself, but it becomes binding as soon as a contract, a tender or a customer specification calls it up - which in practice is how most foreign buyers meet it. It was issued on 3 July 2015 by the General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine of the People's Republic of China; Standardization Administration of China, and has been in force since 2 November 2015. 3.1 Forest tending foresttendingoperations From young forest canopy forest to collectively stand before maturity According to cultivate various silvicultural measures taken by the

3.2 Tree Species objectivesuitable for local site conditions, to stabilize growth, in line with the business objectives of the species.

3.3 Target tree goaltree Purpose tree species, stand for stability and productivity play a significant role in growing good, excellent quality, long life, high-value, long-term Retained until the target diameter before cutting and uses of forests.

3.4 Prickly wolftree Party in the destination tree, huge crown, affect the normal growth of the target tree, non-target species of trees to be removed.

3.5 Tending felling intermediatecutting According stand development, competition and natural forest law and forest thinning cultivation objectives, timely and appropriate Fachu part forest, species composition adjustment And stand density, stand structure optimization, improve forest growth and environmental conditions, and promote the growth of remaining trees, shorten the cycle of foster silviculture measures.
