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Packaging sacks - Vocabulary and types - Part 3: Woven sacks

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Foreword

GB/T 17858 "Terms and Types of Packaging Bags" is divided into three parts.

---Part 1: Paper bags;

---Part 2: Thermoplastic flexible film bags;

---Part 3: Woven bags.

This part is Part 3 of GB/T 17858.

This section was drafted in accordance with the rules given in GB/T 1.1-2009.

This part is proposed and managed by the National Packaging Standardization Technical Committee (SAC/TC49).

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1 Scope

This part of GB/T 17858 defines the general terms of woven bags, as well as the terms of

type, construction details, materials, parts and directions.

This section applies to single-layer or multi-layer packaging bags made of woven cloth of various materials or processed by woven cloth and other tough materials.

Some are not applicable to retail product packaging bags and container bags.

2.1 Woven bag

A packaging container made of woven cloth or flat woven cloth tube with at least one end closed.

Note: In order to make the woven bag reach the performance required for the filling and circulation of goods, the woven cloth or flat woven cloth bag can be compounded with other tough materials.

2.2 Ply

A piece of woven cloth or other tough materials that make up the wall of the bag, or a composite of these materials.

2.3 Frill gusset

Edgefold M-shapeedge

The longitudinal edge of the bag tube or bag is folded inwards to grip the part.

2.4 Bag tube

Cut into a flat cylindrical layer of specified length.

Note: The bag can be one or more layers.

2.4.1 Flat tube

The longitudinal edge has no folded clamping part, and the bag tube is only composed of a flat tube.

2.4.2 Frilled bag tube gussetedtube

The longitudinal edge has a bag tube that folds inwards and clips in.

2.5 Stitching; stitching

Use sutures to join together.

2.6 Adhesive bonding

Use adhesive to bond together.
