1 Scope

GB/T 17924-2025 is the Chinese national standard covering how a geographical indication standard is written - the definition of the area and why it matters, the varieties or breeds, the production method that must be followed there, and the characteristics that distinguish the product. It is the template behind the Moutai, Panyong tea and Hanyuan pepper standards published this year. It replaces GB/T 17924-2008. It was issued on 2 December 2025 and has been in force since 1 July 2026, replacing GB/T 17924-2008. The document is under the responsibility of the China National Intellectual Property Administration. This page is published from the official record of the 2025 edition; the clause text of a standard this recent is not yet in circulation, and the figures, limits and tables it contains are those of the document itself, delivered in full with the English translation.

This document specifies the general requirements for the compilation of quality standards for geographical indication products, including the document name, structure, and elements. This document applies to the formulation of quality requirements standards for geographical indication products that have been legally approved and recognized by the State Council's intellectual property administration department. 3 Terms and Definitions

The terms and definitions defined in GB/T 44584, as well as the following terms and definitions, apply to this document.

3.1 Products originating from a specific region possess qualities, reputations, or other characteristics that are essentially dependent on the natural and human factors of that region. product.

Note. This includes agricultural and livestock products from this region, as well as raw materials that are wholly or partially sourced from this region and processed in this region according to specific regulations. Products manufactured and processed by art. [Source: GB/T 44584-2024, 3.1]

4 General Requirements

4.1 Documents shall be drafted in accordance with the provisions of GB/T 1.1.

4.2 The drafting of the document should highlight the quality characteristics of the geographical indication product, reflecting its authenticity, regionality, distinctiveness, and relevance. Connection.

4.3 The geographical indication product names, place of origin, quality requirements, etc., mentioned in the document should be consistent with the requirements of the State Council's intellectual property administration department regarding geographical indications. The protection requirements are consistent with those in the certification announcement for products with the brand mark.

5.1 File Name

5.1.1 The document name should be the name of the geographical indication product preceded by "Geographical Indication Product Quality Requirements".
