--- Increase the technical requirements of the foam-type stool and relevant content.

1 Scope

GB/T 18092-2008 is the Chinese national standard on watre-free sanitary toilet, in the field of construction materials and building. The /T suffix marks it as a recommended standard: it is not compulsory by itself, but it becomes binding as soon as a contract, a tender or a customer specification calls it up - which in practice is how most foreign buyers meet it. It was issued on 11 December 2008 by the General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine of the People's Republic of China; Standardization Administration of China, and has been in force since 1 August 2009. Classification: ICS 91.040.10, CCS P33. This standard specifies the terms and definitions for Free sanitary flush toilet (hereinafter referred to as WC) and toilet, classification and marking method to performance Requirements, test methods, inspection rules, signs and brochures, transport, storage and installation. This standard applies to dry-free sanitary toilets and barreled plastic packaged for Free flush toilet and a foam block type toilet design, Manufacturing and product acceptance.

3 Terms and Definitions

The following terms and definitions apply to this standard.

3.1 Using packaged or foam-type toilet stool, meets stringent hygiene standards toilet.

3.2 Barreled package using plastic bags to clean up manure toilet.

3.3 Using foam covering and mechanically blocked fecal odor, and through the foam and the liquid in the toilet and fell downstream pipeline transporting manure Toilet.
