## 1 Scope

GB/T 18266.5-2023 is the Chinese national standard on ranking standards for sports facilities - part 5: star-rating standard for ski resorts, in the field of domestic and commercial equipment, entertainment, sport. The /T suffix marks it as a recommended standard: it is not compulsory by itself, but it becomes binding as soon as a contract, a tender or a

customer specification calls it up - which in practice is how most foreign buyers meet it. It was issued on 18 July 2023 by the State Administration for Market Regulation; Standardization Administration of China, and has been in force since 1 February 2024. Classification: ICS 97.220, CCS Y55. This page is published from the official record of the standard held by the Chinese standards administration: the identification, the dates, the classification and the issuing body are taken from there.
