1 Scope

GB/T 21667-2024 is the Chinese national standard on general rules of the second-hand goods qualification, in the field of environment and health protection, safety. The /T suffix marks it as a recommended standard: it is not compulsory by itself, but it becomes binding as soon as a contract, a tender or a customer specification calls it up - which in practice is how most foreign buyers meet it. It was issued on 31 December 2024 by the State Administration for Market Regulation; Standardization Administration of China, and has been in force since 31 December 2024. Classification: ICS 13.020.01, CCS Z 04. This page is published from the official record of the standard held by the Chinese standards administration: the identification, the dates, the classification and the issuing body are taken from there. The clause text, the tables and the numeric limits are in the document itself, which is delivered complete in English translation.

This document defines the relevant terms and definitions in the process of second-hand goods quality identification; stipulates the identification institutions and personnel, identification process, identification Contents, quality grading and identification report; describes identification methods. This document is applicable to the quality appraisal of second-hand goods for recirculation. This document is not applicable to second-hand goods for research, appreciation, and collection.

3 Terms and definitions

The following terms and definitions apply to this document.

3.1 Second-hand goods Items that have entered the fields of production and consumption and daily life consumption and retain part or all of their original use value.

3.2 Quality The quality of the second-hand goods' functions and the degree of defects in their appearance.

3.3 Qualification Activities that use scientific methods, professional knowledge, and technical means to identify the quality level of second-hand goods.

4.1 Identification Agency

4.1.1 The appraisal institution shall establish a fair and independent management system and form relevant management systems, including but not limited to.

- Quality management system;
- Job management system for appraisal personnel;
- Equipment, facilities and resource management system;
- Information security and confidentiality management system;
- Identification records and preservation management system;
- Identification report or certificate management system;
- Complaint and appeal management system;
- Safety production management system.

4.1.2 The appraisal institution shall have 5 or more professional and technical personnel engaged in the appraisal of second-hand goods conducted by the appraisal institution.

4.1.3 The appraisal institution shall be equipped with the venue, facilities, equipment, systems and service resources required for the appraisal activities according to the

categories of second-hand goods to be appraised.

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
