1 Scope

GB/T 22044-2017 is the Chinese national standard on anthropometric definitions and methods for infants garment, in the field of clothing industry. The /T suffix marks it as a recommended standard: it is not compulsory by itself, but it becomes binding as soon as a contract, a tender or a customer specification calls it up - which in practice is how most foreign buyers meet it. It was issued on 29 December 2017 by the General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine of the People's Republic of China; Standardization Administration of China, and has been in force since 1 July 2018. Classification: ICS 61.020, CCS Y75. This page is published from the official record of the standard held by the Chinese standards administration: the identification, the dates, the classification and the issuing body are taken from there. The clause text, the tables and the numeric limits are in the document itself, which is delivered complete in English translation.

This standard specifies the dimensions and methods of infant measurement of body measurements. This standard applies to the age of 36 months and below infants body measurement. NOTE Not all of the body sizes defined in this standard are required for the production of baby clothes.

3 Size definition

3.1 Overview The size definitions are listed in the natural order of measurement and include the following three sections.

- a) the horizontal size (including the size of the circumference);
- b) vertical size;
- c) other dimensions. The order of vertical dimensions is measured, starting with the size of

the human body measured with a human altimeter and then with the size of the human body measured with a soft ruler. Note The instruments and measurement methods mentioned in the definition are specified in Chapter 4.

3.2 horizontal size

3.2.1 Head circumference headband Subjects were upright, the head facing the front, with a soft ruler around the top of the eyebrow around the pillow after measuring the maximum horizontal circumference measured hair Included.

3.2.2 Neck circumference neck-basegirth The seventh cervical vertebra point, the lateral neck point and neck densitometry measured neck circumference.

3.2.3 Shoulder length shoulderlength Subjects arm drooping naturally, measured from the lateral neck point to the acromion point body distance.

3.2.4 Total shoulder backshoulderwidth Subjects arm drooping naturally, measuring the horizontal arc length between the acromion points.
