1 Scope

GB/T 22503-2008 is the Chinese national standard on high oil corn, in the field of food technology. The /T suffix marks it as a recommended standard: it is not compulsory by itself, but it becomes binding as soon as a contract, a tender or a customer specification calls it up - which in practice is how most foreign buyers meet it. It was issued on 4 November 2008 by the General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine of the People's Republic of China; Standardization Administration of China, and has been in force since 20 January 2009. 3 Terms and Definitions

The following terms and definitions apply to this standard.

3.1 Dry fat content of not less than the minimum target of this standard corn prescribed.

3.2 Fat mass fraction of the dry sample.

3.3 Use value but there are damaged corn particles.

3.3.1 Insects, decay, and the formation of particles or Wormhole tunnel.

3.3.2 Grain with spots, hurt embryos or endosperm particles.

3.3.3 Grain broken up one-fifth of the particle volume (or more) of the particles.
