1 Scope

GB/T 22514-2008 is the Chinese national standard on rapeseed meal, in the field of food technology. The /T suffix marks it as a recommended standard: it is not compulsory by itself, but it becomes binding as soon as a contract, a tender or a customer specification calls it up - which in practice is how most foreign buyers meet it. It was issued on 4 November 2008 by the General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine of the People's Republic of China; Standardization Administration of China, and has been in force since 20 January 2009. This standard specifies the terms and definitions related to rapeseed, classification, quality and health requirements, test methods, inspection rules, labels and Logo and packaging, storage and transportation requirements. 3 Terms and Definitions

The following terms and definitions apply to this standard.

3.1 Rapeseed oil leached and removed the solvent to obtain the material.

3.2 Rapeseed meal nitrogenous substances in general.

3.3 Rapeseed meal does not dissolve in water, ether, ethanol, dilute acids and alkaline substances.

3.4 Rapeseed meal remaining material after high temperature burning.

3.5 Glucosinolate known as glucosinolates. Total glucosinolate content per gram of rapeseed meal (moisture content 8.5%) in the number of sulfur-containing glycosides micro Moore said.
