It was issued on 30 December 2008 by the General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine of the People's Republic of China; Standardization Administration of China, and has been in force since 1 June 2009. 2.2 Circulation Cooperation Organization (2.1) the main form of organization. Is a voluntary association of people, through common ownership and democratic management, to meet together through Enterprise self-organization of economic and social needs.
