1 Scope

GB/T 22937-2008 is the Chinese national standard on commercial washing machine, in the field of domestic and commercial equipment, entertainment, sport. The /T suffix marks it as a recommended standard: it is not compulsory by itself, but it becomes binding as soon as a contract, a tender or a customer specification calls it up - which in practice is how most foreign buyers meet it. It was issued on 30 December 2008 by the General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine of the People's Republic of China; Standardization Administration of China, and has been in force since 1 September 2009. Classification: ICS 97.060, CCS Y62. This standard specifies the terms and definitions of commercial washing machines, product

classification, technical requirements, test methods, inspection rules, marking, packaging, transport and storage. 3 Terms and Definitions

The following terms and definitions apply to this standard.

3.1 Commercial Washing Machines

3.1.1 Water as washing medium, the use of power-driven, relying on mechanical action of washing laundry appliances.

3.1.2 Quality under specified operating conditions, can be washed (or dehydration)
Maximum load refers to the ambient laboratory conditions before washing dry storage Load mass (moisture content of 8%).

3.1.3 Drum net volume (L) and the rated washing capacity (kg) ratio.

3.2.1 The use of chemical solvents for cleaning fabrics.
