2 Terms and definitions

2.1 In wandering, begging the way to survive life without staff.

2.2 Eighteens, effective from the guardian care, relying on wandering, begging, etc. to maintain the staff of life.

2.3 Temporarily encountered unexpected difficulties to survive and provide temporary help services.

2.4 As vagrants and beggars to provide temporary services agencies organized various subjects.

2.5 Government set for life without the vagrants and beggars, living temporarily encountered unexpected difficulties in personnel to provide temporary relief tube Management institutions.

2.6 Government department set up to provide temporary relief for homeless minors, protection and education of the specialized agencies.

2.7 Various types of aid agencies to provide assistance requested behavior.

2.8 Relief agencies to help audit staff situation and decide whether to provide assistance in the process.

2.9 Relief agencies for reasons of old age, young, disability, can not provide the personal circumstances of the person asking for assistance, after the first screening of rescue mode.

2.10 Street and other public places for vagrants and beggars field personnel to carry out persuasion, emergency help, guide escort and other activities.
