4 Competence requirements

The certification body shall define each accreditation based on Chapters 5, 6, and 7 of this part and Table A.1 of ISO /IEC 17021-1..2011.

The competency requirements of the certification function.

Note 1. Appendix A provides a summary of information on the competence requirements of personnel involved in specific certification functions.

NOTE 2 Information on audit principles is given in ISO 19011.

Note 3. The certification body has the responsibility to define the depth of competence requirements, which can distinguish the competence requirements of auditors and personnel performing other certification functions.

5.1 General

Road traffic safety auditors shall have the general capabilities described in ISO /IEC 17021-1..2011 and

The knowledge of road traffic safety.

Note. Each auditor in the audit team need not have the same competence, but the overall competence of the audit team needs to be sufficient to achieve the audit objectives.

5.2 Road traffic safety terms, principles, processes and concepts, including safety systems approach

Road traffic safety auditors should have road traffic safety terms, principles, processes, concepts outlined in ISO 39001 and its appendix
