1 Scope

This standard specifies the national export phytosanitary certificate verification content.

3 Terms and Definitions

Terms and definitions GB/T 20478-2006 defined apply to this document.

4 Statutory Bodies

CIQ is the only country designated or authorized by management and issue export phytosanitary certificates. In the exercise of this level

Temporary, entry-exit inspection and quarantine authorities should.

- a) have the power to take legal action;
- b) take measures to prevent conflicts of interest, fraudulent use of certificates and so on. Inspection and quarantine authorities have the right to prevent incompatible

Exports of goods and quarantine requirements of the importing country.

5 Management responsibility

Inspection and quarantine authorities have the following duties.

- a) establish a management system to ensure compliance with management standards, legal requirements and administrative regulations and other requirements;
- b) designate a person or department responsible for export and certification system management;
- c) the certificate clearly responsible personnel responsibilities and contact details;
- d) ensure that adequate personnel and resources to fulfill the following functions.

- Of the importing country phytosanitary information for maintenance;
- Development of production operations guidelines to conform to the phytosanitary requirements of the importing country;
- Carry cargo inspection, testing and inspection of vehicles;
- Pest found during the inspection of goods were identified;
- Verify the authenticity and integrity of phytosanitary procedures;
- Phytosanitary certificate issued;
- Save and retrieve files;
