Introduction

In order to standardize the safety requirements of hand-held non-electric power tools, in

order to protect the health of operators and the safety of equipment and the environment, the international standard

The International Organization has released ISO 11148, a total of 13 documents. Our country intends to adopt 13 partial documents of ISO 11148, which are formulated as

The corresponding parts of GB/T 32800 documents. GB/T 32800 is proposed to be constituted as follows.

--- Part 1.Assembly power tools for non-threaded structural fasteners. Covers riveting machines, riveting or plugging tools, broken bar lock bolts

Tools, mandrel riveting tools, rivet nut holders.

--- Part 2.Cutting off and crimping power tools. Covers non-yoke crimpers, cutters, cut-off tools, cutting pliers, crimping pliers.

--- Part 3.Drilling and tapping machines. Covers drills, double handle heavy drills, tapping machines.

--- Part 4.Pure impact power tools. Covers breakers, chisels, shovels, engraving pens, descaling hammers, picks, portable pile drivers, driver

Presses, compactors, stone hammers, shovels, tamping machines.

--- Part 5.Rotary impact drilling tools. Covering small blasthole drills, rock drills, and rotary hammers.

--- Part 6.Assembly power tools for threaded fasteners. Covers hydraulic pulse gas triggers, impact wrenches, fastener installation tools,

Nutrunner, open end wrench, ratchet wrench, screwdriver.

--- Part 7.Grinders. Covers grinding grinders, cut-off grinders, polishers and buffers using pot and leaf wheels.

--- Part 8.Grinders and polishers. Covers belt grinders, slide grinders, polishers, duplex grinders, linear grinders

--- Part 9.Grinders for molds. Covering Angle Die Grinders, Reciprocating Files, Rotary Files, Linear Die Grinders

turbine.

--- Part 10.Squeeze power tools. Covers crimping tools, ring part breakers, metal forming tools, nut splitters,

Extruders, printers, extrusion riveters, cutting tools with parallel blades, jaw extrusion pliers.

--- Part 11. Punching and shearing machines and scissors. Covers punching and shearing machines, scissors.

--- Part 12. Disc, pendulum and reciprocating saws. Covers circular saws, circular knives, saw blades with a radius of less than 50 mm or

Oscillating saws with diamond cutting blades up to a radius of 100 mm, pendulum knives, reciprocating saws including fine saws and bow saws.

--- Part 13. Fastener driving tools.

Safety requirements for hand-held non-electric power tools

Part 10. Squeeze-type power tools

1 Scope

This document applies to hand-held non-electric power supplies for extrusion riveting, stamping, forming, and pressure cutting of metals, plastics, and other materials.

Tools (hereinafter referred to as "squeeze power tools"). Extrusion power tools can be powered by compressed air, hydraulic oil or an internal combustion engine, with or without

In the case of a suspension device (such as a balance device), it is intended for use by an operator with one or two hands.

Note 1. At the time of publication of this document, the existence of extrusion power tools driven by internal combustion engines has not been known. This document will be updated once the existence of such power tools is confirmed.

This document applies to the following products.

- Withholding tools;
- Ring part breaker;
- Tools for metal forming (edge formers, folding tools, fasteners);
- Nut splitter;
- extruder;
- printer;
- Extrusion riveter;
- Cutting tools with parallel blades;
- Jaw squeeze pliers.

Note 2. See Appendix B for examples of extrusion power tools.

This document does not apply to special requirements and modifications to extrusion-type power tools for mounting them on holding devices.

This document deals with reasonably foreseeable errors in intended use and at the factory, other than the use of extruded power tools in potentially explosive atmospheres.

All noteworthy hazards, hazardous conditions or hazardous occurrences when using the tool under the conditions of use.

Note 3. EN13463-1 gives the requirements for the use of non-electrical equipment in potentially explosive atmospheres.
