1 Scope

China's national standard for woven garments for infants and young children. It specifies the terms and definitions, the requirements, the test methods, the inspection classification rules, and the marking, packaging, transport and storage, and it applies to infant garments made principally from woven textile fabrics, with hats, gloves, socks, bibs and similar products able to refer to it. Infant clothing is regulated more tightly than any other category of garment, and for reasons that have nothing to do with fashion. A baby's skin is thinner and more permeable than an adult's, its surface area relative to body mass is far larger, and it will put whatever it is wearing into its mouth. So a dye that would be harmless against adult skin, at a concentration that would pass in an adult garment, is not acceptable here, and the safety requirements of GB 31701 for infant and children's textile products sit behind this standard as the floor beneath it. What this document adds is the product specification: the appearance, the workmanship, the dimensional stability after washing, the colour fastness to washing, rubbing, perspiration and saliva, the seam strength, and the fibre content, along with how each is inspected and classified. Colour fastness to saliva is the requirement that marks the category out, and it exists for the obvious reason. So do the provisions on trims and fastenings, since a button that comes off a baby's garment is an aspiration hazard rather than an inconvenience. Issued on 13 December 2016 and in force since 1 July 2017.

This standard specifies the terms and definitions of woven infant clothing, requirements,

test methods, inspection classification rules, and signs, packaging, transport And storage. This standard applies to the textile fabrics as the main fabric production of infant clothing. Textile fabrics as the main fabric production of infants and young children Hats, gloves, socks, bibs and other products can refer to this standard.
