With the rapid development of information technology, the pace of sports informatization in my country is getting faster and faster. The construction of sports information system and the flow of sports information are becoming more and more important. Communication and sharing have become an important aspect and means to support the high-quality development of sports. From information collection, storage, retrieval, exchange and aggregation to information Resource sharing requires the description, definition, classification and coding of various information so that they have a common language and can give full play to the social role of information systems. Therefore, how to classify and code sports information scientifically, orderly, uniformly and in a standardized manner is the key to realizing informatization. The primary issue that needs to be solved urgently is one of the important basic tasks of sports informatization, which plays a vital role in the process of sports informatization. The content of sports information is extremely rich, covering sports training and competition, sports fitness and entertainment, sports economy and industry, sports organizations and institutions. In order to promote the smooth progress of information classification and coding, we should do a good job in top-level design and organize the system from the overall perspective. It is the consensus of scientists and standard workers in this field to formulate corresponding national standards for classification and coding. GB/T 34308 aims to establish information classification and coding applicable to the sports industry and is intended to consist of five parts.

1. Classification and Coding Guidelines. The purpose is to establish the uniformity and coordination of the sports information classification and coding system, and to provide a basis for the classification and coding of sports information. The information classification and coding system has achieved strict logic, compact structure and scientific progress, which is convenient for the use and maintenance of the sports information classification and coding system. Protection is a necessary condition for the sports information classification and coding system to have good extensibility.

2. Sports competition event codes. The purpose is to establish the classification and coding of sports information of sports competition events.

3. Sports Physiological, Biochemical and Nutritional Index Code. The purpose is to establish sports information codes for sports physiological, biochemical and nutritional indicators. Classification and coding of information.

4. Sports medicine indicator codes. The purpose is to establish the classification and coding of sports information of sports medicine indicators.

5. Sports venue codes. The purpose is to establish the classification and coding of sports information of sports venues. This document is drafted to meet the needs of systematic summarization and standardized expression of sports venues. It is mainly used for sports venue information statistics and information Management, information processing, information exchange and information sharing aim to standardize the classification information of sports venues, build a sports venue statistical survey system, and provide

1 Scope

GB/T 34308.5-2024 is the sports venue part of the Chinese sport information classification and coding series. China runs a national census of sports facilities and allocates public investment on the basis of it, which makes the classification consequential: whether a school playground, a fitness trail, a swimming pool or a stadium is counted, and under what heading, determines the provision figures a district is measured against. The standard sets the basis of the classification and the classification of venues itself, then the coding principles, the code structure and the code table assigning a code to every venue type, together with the rules for extending the classification and for maintaining the codes. It is the reference used by the sports administration information systems, by the venue census and by the applications built on them. It takes effect on 1 February 2025.

This document establishes the classification basis, coding principles and coding rules for sports venues, and provides classification and classification codes that reflect the classification results. and category name. This document is applicable to the classification and coding of sports venues in the management of the sports industry, and is used for information statistics, information management, information processing, Information exchange and information sharing.

The terms and definitions defined in GB/T 7027, GB/T 10113 and GB/T 20001.3 and the following apply to this document.

3.1 Sports Venue A general term for various venues for sports training, competitions, and fitness activities.

3.2 Sports venues are differentiated and classified according to their usage attributes or

characteristics.

3.3 Sports Venue Code Based on the classification of sports venues, a code with certain regularity, easy to identify and process is used to identify various types of sports venues.

4.1 Classification basis Based on the official sports events in my country, the identification and specificity, standardization and applicability of the venue are comprehensively considered. Similarities and differences, as well as national policy planning, project popularity, public attention and other factors, while taking into account management needs, traditional Sports venues are classified based on differences in habits and functions.
