3:1 A place where conditions such as temperature, humidity, carbon dioxide concentration, oxygen concentration and ethylene concentration can be adjusted:

3:2 Chilling requirement The number of weeks of effective cold temperatures required for tulips to release their natural dormancy:

3:3 bulb plateau The semi-disc-shaped raised area at the base of the bulb where roots can grow:

3:4 Bulbs that have not been treated with cold temperatures:

3:5 5°C treatment bulbs Bulbs that have been treated at 5°C to meet the cooling requirements of this variety:

3:6 9°C treatment bulbs After 9 to 10 weeks of 9°C treatment, the bulbs have not yet met all the cooling requirements:

3:7 seed ball bullet Bulb bulbs for propagation of producer variety bulbs:
