**Evaluation specification for student's athletic ability of football
course**

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Foreword

This document is in accordance with the provisions of GB/T 1.1-2020 "Guidelines for standardization work Part

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1 Scope

GB/T 43983-2024 is the Chinese national standard for evaluating a student's athletic ability in a football course. It is an unusual kind of document: a national standard that defines, sport by sport, a six-grade ladder of ability running from primary school through university, with the attainment requirements for each grade and the test procedures used to establish whether a student has reached it. The purpose is to make physical education assessable and comparable across a school system of enormous size, so that a grade means the same thing in one province as in another. The standard sets the grading scheme and the attainment requirements for each of the six grades, then gives the evaluation for each grade in turn, some twenty-seven pages of test items covering technique, physical qualities, tactical understanding and match play, each with its setup, procedure and scoring. A normative annex does the same again for goalkeepers, whose ability cannot be measured with the outfield tests. It applies to the evaluation of football ability of students at primary, junior secondary, senior secondary and university level.

This document stipulates the classification and achievement requirements of the athletic ability levels of students in the football course, and describes the evaluation methods for each level. This document is applicable to the assessment of football athletic ability of students in primary school, junior high school, high school and university.

3 Terms and definitions

The following terms and definitions apply to this document.

- 3.1 The comprehensive skills formed by students in football courses, practice and competition activities, and the application of dribbling, passing, shooting and other skills to complete specific tasks in the game Combined performance.
- 3.2 footballpassing The action of using an effective part of the body to hit a football towards a predetermined target.
- 3.3 dribblingfootballdribbling The athlete purposefully pushes the ball with his feet continuously while running.
- 3.4 football receiving The action of actively catching a running football in the desired position using effective parts of the body.
- 3.5 shooting The action of using effective parts of the body to hit the football towards the goal.
- 3.6 Fixed ball fixedbal The ball is at rest and no longer moving or spinning.
- 3.7 moving ball movingbal The process of moving a ball from one location to another.
