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The construction of sports parks is a solution to the problem of "where to go for fitness" for the masses, expanding the supply of national fitness services, and meeting the diversity of mass sports needs. This document is formulated on the basis of the Sports Law of the People's Republic of China (Promulgated by the Thirteenth National People's Congress on June 24, 2022) The provisions of Article 85 of the General Assembly Standing Committee (amended at the 35th meeting) shall be implemented through the implementation of this document to implement the national strategy of national fitness and The Outline of the "Healthy China 2030" Plan implements the Guiding Opinions on Promoting the Construction of Sports Parks and the Guiding Opinions on Building a Higher Level of National Health. This document is the basic standard for guiding the construction of sports parks in my country, aiming to build a universal sports park. Applicable to the sports configuration system of new construction, reconstruction and expansion of sports parks, making full use of existing park conditions and other public places to build fitness facilities Facilities will be used to create a new green and convenient platform for national fitness.

Sports Park Configuration Requirements

1 Scope

GB/T 44092-2024 sets the configuration requirements for sports parks in China. The sports park is a specific policy instrument: China is building them in large numbers to raise physical activity, and public money follows a definition, so what counts as one and what it must contain has to be specified rather than left to a local interpretation that would let any park with a footpath qualify. The standard sets the classification of sports parks by scale, and then the configuration requirements: the site and area, the proportion of the park that must be given to sports facilities and the proportion of green space, the categories of facility required at each scale, from fitness trails and outdoor equipment through courts and pitches to indoor provision, the accessibility and the provision for older people and children, the ancillary facilities of changing, sanitation, lighting, parking and signage, the safety requirements, and the operation, maintenance and management arrangements. It takes effect on 1 September 2024.

This document stipulates the basic requirements of sports parks, sports events and venue facilities configuration requirements, and gives the requirements for sports parks based on

land area. Classification of sports parks. This document applies to the planning, design and construction of sports project configuration and venue facilities in newly built, renovated and expanded sports parks.
