4 Content display principles

The content display principles are as follows.

Abide by public order and good customs, refrain from inappropriate speech, and conform to the correct political direction, value orientation and public opinion orientation; a) The content is complete and the semantics is clear; b) Have legal copyright. c)

5.1 General requirements

Audio content should use the mainstream universal format of digital audio. File size and production date should be marked for visually impaired people, and navigation settings should be set.

Sound tags. add corresponding levels of navigation notifications or prompt sounds according to the content and chapters of the audiobook, and explain what each level contains. Content.

5.2 Sound Presentation

Sound presentation should meet the following requirements.
