3 Terms and definitions

The following terms and definitions apply to this document.

3.1 container intermodal transport

A form of multimodal transport that uses containers as transport units.

3.2 Intermodal transport operator

A combined transport operator who signs a multimodal transport contract with the shipper and assumes full responsibility for the transportation process.

3.3 Intermodal transport waybill

The cargo information, multimodal transport participants and the carrier information of each section are recorded by the multimodal transport operator, the shipper and each The contract document or component for the section carrier to carry out multimodal transport.
