4.4 Adhere to government guidance and social promotion, support urban and rural residents, funeral service agencies, social organizations, social workers, volunteers and other organizations to promote the festival Ecological burial.

5 Categories

Land-saving ecological burials are classified according to different burial methods, see Table 1.
