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Guidelines for setting up a cognitive impairment-friendly environment in nursing homes

1 Scope

This document establishes the general principles for the establishment of a dementia-friendly environment in nursing homes, provides general settings and Guidance on setting up spaces such as bathing, transportation, dining and activities.

This document is applicable to the environmental setting of dementia care units in nursing homes, and is also applicable to general nursing homes to promote cognitive function in the elderly. Play environment settings.

3 Terms and definitions

The following terms and definitions apply to this document.

3.1 Cognitive impairment

Impairment or decline in function in one or more cognitive areas.

Note. Cognitive domains include complex attention, executive function, learning and memory, language, sensory-motor function, and social cognition.

3.2 cognitive impairment friendly environment

A special environment set up to compensate or enhance the cognitive function of the elderly.

Note. The purpose is to enhance the autonomy and independence of elderly people with cognitive impairment, maintain their individual dignity, and promote their social interaction and meaningful participation.

4.1 Security

Minimize the risk factors in the environment that may lead to various adverse events in the elderly, and control dangerous items in the environment.

Safety measures should be as concealed as possible to maintain the dignity of the elderly.

4.2 Familiarity

Create a friendly, familiar and personalized home-style environment to meet the personal preferences of the elderly or continue their living habits.

4.3 Stability

Fix the layout and location of facilities and equipment within the space, and avoid frequent changes in living units and bed positions.
