3 Terms and Definitions

The following terms and definitions apply to this document.

3.1 forest village

The natural landscape of the countryside is well preserved, the forest atmosphere is rich, the forest ecosystem is healthy and stable, the green industry has obvious benefits, and the living environment and A harmonious and beautiful administrative village.

3.2 folklore forest

Forests and trees that are closely related to local customs, recognized by local villagers, or protected by township and village rules and regulations.

4 Evaluation Index System

The national forest village evaluation index system consists of 6 first-level indicators and 23 second-level indicators.

landscape, natural landscape, ecological protection, biodiversity, human settlement environment, etc.; in terms of rural greening, the village green coverage rate, surrounding Greening, yard greening, public green space, abandoned land greening, etc.; greening quality evaluation of plant selection, seedling selection, greening configuration, etc.

Content. In terms of greening management and protection, the forest chief system, management and protection system, greening achievement management and protection, disaster prevention and control, etc. are evaluated; in terms of green industry, the masses are evaluated Increase income, develop characteristic industries, etc.; in terms of rural ecological culture, evaluate the protection of ancient and famous trees, folk forests and other ecological and cultural heritage, and popularize natural science.
