1 Scope

This document proposes the functional positioning, general principles, and construction conditions of national park entrance communities, and provides a basis for construction layout, facility system, and green development.

Provide guidance on development, co-construction and sharing.

This document applies to the construction, management, and operation of national park entrance communities.

3 Terms and definitions

The following terms and definitions apply to this document.

3.1 Village clusters (residential areas) that provide services such as ecological protection

Located at the main nodes of the national park entrance and exit roads, adjacent to or across the national park boundaries, it provides a good opportunity for national park recreational experience, scientific research, education and life.

4.1 Dominant Function

National park entrance communities should have the following dominant functions.

- It has the function of a national park gateway area. Visitors can get transportation distribution, consultation guidance, leisure shopping and other corresponding services at the entrance community. Serve.
- Display the characteristics of the national park's ecosystem, biodiversity, natural landscape, natural relics, etc., and carry out popular science education and ecological experience, etc. Activity.
- Build a comprehensive platform for cooperation between national park management agencies and relevant local management agencies and local communities.

- Provide a platform for the general public to participate in protection, construction and cultural inheritance.

4.2 Combined functions

National park entrance communities can combine the following functions.

- Cultivate green industries. Make use of the resources and location conditions of the national park and its surrounding areas, and give full play to the national park's own brand and characteristic resources.
