1 Scope

GB/T 45194-2024 sets the general requirements for classic vehicles in China, and it is the document that creates the category. Until now a thirty-year-old car in China was simply an old car, subject to scrappage rules, emission limits and inspection regimes written for vehicles in daily use, which is why almost nothing survived. It defines the terms and definitions for traditional historical vehicles and stipulates the requirements for their certification, and it applies to the certification of such vehicles legally held in China or intended to be brought into China. It sets out what a traditional historical vehicle is, the age and originality criteria a vehicle has to meet, the classification into grades according to the degree of originality and preservation, the requirements on the condition of the vehicle and on the authenticity of its components, the rules on permitted restoration and on the documentation of it, the identification and technical inspection requirements, and the appraisal procedure and the records that support it. It is the foundation of a classic vehicle market in China: registration, insurance, valuation and the limited road use allowed all follow from the appraisal this document defines.

This document defines the terms and definitions of traditional classic cars, sets out the requirements for recognition and information management, and establishes the recognition process. This document applies to the identification of traditional classic cars that are legally held in China or legally imported into my country.

3 Terms and definitions

The terms and definitions defined in GB/T 3730.1, GB/T 5359.1 and GA802 and the following apply to this document.

3.1 A car or motorcycle that meets all of the following conditions.

---Driven by machinery.

---Not less than 30 years from first manufacture or registration.

---Keep the vehicle in its original condition and do not include copies and/or replicas. The technical characteristics have not changed substantially. The motorcycle has the original

fuel tank or the current fuel tank, and is equipped with the original exhaust equipment or the original The exhaust equipment is the same as the factory design, and the seats are original or similar in appearance to the original ones.

---Not to be used as a daily means of transportation. For those who need to drive on the road, they should comply with the laws, regulations and provisions on road traffic safety management.

---Have certain technical value or historical and cultural value.

4.1 Basic vehicle information and status

4.1.1 The vehicle should have the original brand information, the original vehicle identification code or the original vehicle unique identification number of the time, the engine number,
