3 Terms and definitions

The terms and definitions defined in GB/T 33384 and the following apply to this document.

3.1 The shoes you wear

It has a stable and non-slip structure design and is made of rubber, plastic or other high molecular elastic body as the main material for the elderly to use in bathing places.

3.2 stability performance

Through structural design and other means, the anti-slip degree between the sole and the insole, and between the sole and the ground is improved, so that the elderly can be in a stable position when wearing it. state.
