4 Origin and characteristics of varieties

The origin of Xiang pig is Congjiang, Guizhou and Huanjiang, Guangxi. The central production area is located in Zaibian, Bingmei, Jiajiu and Jiabang townships in Congjiang County, Guizhou Province.

Town, as well as Minglun and Dongxing towns in Huanjiang County, Guangxi. It has the characteristics of early maturity, easy fertilizer, strong resistance to adversity, small size and fragrant meat.

5 Body shape and appearance

The hair color of the fragrant pig is mainly black, with a few white or partially white foreheads, tail tips and limbs; the body is short, short and plump; the head is medium-sized, the face is The back of a boar is straight, with many wrinkles on the forehead; the mouth is round, the ears are small and drooping, the neck is short and thick, and the chest is deep and narrow. The back of a boar is relatively straight or slightly concave, and the rump is often slanted.

The pig is concave, with a large and drooping abdomen, and the hind legs are mostly lying down. There are 5 to 7 pairs of effective nipples. See Appendix A for photos of the fragrant pig.

6 Adult weight and size

The body weight and body size of adult boars (23-25 months old) and adult sows (third parity, 2 months of gestation) should meet the requirements of Table 1. Require.

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
