This document specifies the basic requirements, service content, service process and management, safety management, information management, etc. of building structure cleaning services.

3 Terms and definitions

The following terms and definitions apply to this document.

3.1 Construction

An engineering entity or accessory built for a specific purpose, but people usually do not directly carry out production and living activities inside it. It is a building facility.

3.2 Cleaning service

Professionals use professional equipment, tools, supplies and cleaning agents to clean objects and their surfaces in accordance with process and operating procedures.

Sweeping, cleaning, wiping and maintenance activities.

3.3 cleaning at heights

Cleaning services performed on the external surface of building structures (3.1) at a distance of 2 m or more from the reference plane of the fall height.

3.4 Cleaning at confined spaces

In a closed or partially closed area, with limited access but personnel can enter or explore, not designed as a fixed workplace, poor ventilation, easy to cause Cleaning services are provided in spaces where toxic, harmful, flammable and explosive substances accumulate or where the oxygen content is insufficient.

3.5 Pest control operation service

Activities to prevent and control harmful organisms that cause damage to building structures and the public environment in occupied areas.
