1 Scope

This document establishes the general principles for the comprehensive utilization of waste from the entire fruit and vegetable industry chain and stipulates the main Utilization methods, collection, storage, transportation and management.

This document applies to the comprehensive utilization of waste generated in the entire fruit and vegetable industry chain as raw materials.

This document does not apply to the utilization of packaging waste and agricultural waste.

3.1

A complete industrial chain system consisting of fruits and vegetables in the links of seedling cultivation, planting, harvesting, processing, storage, transportation and sales.
