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Introduction

In 2014, the State Council issued the "Several Opinions of the State Council on Promoting Fair Competition in the Market and Maintaining Normal Market Order", which proposed "strengthening production Operators should take the main responsibility and establish a self-declaration and supervision system for enterprise product and service standards." On January 1, 2018, the People's Republic of China The Standardization Law of the Republic of China was formally implemented, which explicitly requires the state to implement a self-declaration, disclosure and supervision system for group standards and enterprise standards.

Encourage group standards and enterprise standards to be made public through the standard information public service platform.

The Measures for Promoting Enterprise Standardization have been issued, which set clearer requirements on the scope, content and channels of enterprises' self-declaration of the implementation of standards.

Requirements. encourage enterprises to make self-declarations through the national unified enterprise standard information public service platform and self-disclosure through other channels.

If the declaration is made public, the disclosure channel should be clearly stated on the national unified enterprise standard information public service platform, and the information disclosed in the self-declaration should be Accessible, traceable and tamper-proof.

In accordance with the requirements of the above laws, regulations and system documents, when enterprises perform their obligations to self-declare and disclose the implementation standards, they should give priority to The unified enterprise standard information public service platform (referred to as the unified platform) is used for self-declaration and disclosure, and it is also allowed to choose to disclose information in the industry supervisory The relevant enterprise standard platforms (referred to as sub-platforms) built by the relevant departments or local standardization management departments shall be self-declared and disclosed.

The unified platform and various sub-platforms Platforms need to be interconnected and share information.

Enterprise Standard Self-Declaration Public Data Synchronization Requirements

1 Scope

This document specifies the overall requirements, general information requirements, synchronization management requirements and security requirements for enterprise standard self-declaration of public data synchronization Require.

This document applies to the synchronization, exchange and sharing of data between platform systems at all levels that are responsible for self-declaration and disclosure of corporate standards.

3 Terms and definitions

The following terms and definitions apply to this document.

3.1

In accordance with relevant national regulations, enterprises shall make public the standards for the products they produce or the services they provide.

3.2 data synchronization

Between two or more enterprise standard self-declaration disclosure related platform systems, data is exchanged and transmitted in a predetermined synchronization manner.

The process of data transmission, receipt confirmation, and account verification is carried out to achieve data synchronization and sharing.

3.3

Functional software that realizes data synchronization by integrating third-party software tools.

3.4 Source data system sourcedatasystem

Provide a platform or system for enterprises to self-declare public data in accordance with

standards.

3.5 target data system targetdatasystem

A platform or system for receiving enterprise standard self-declared public data.
