3 Terms and Definitions

The terms and definitions defined in GB/T 12728 and the following apply to this document.

3.1 A type of large fungus in the genus *Pleurotus* of the family *Pleurotaceae*

The fruiting body is generally medium-sized; the cap is initially hemispherical, flat, then gradually warped at the edge, then concave in the middle, light gray to light brown; the flesh is white Color, thick; gills white to light brown, extended, dense; stipe eccentric, rarely lateral, thick, solid, nearly bottle-shaped when young, belonging to the Fungi kingdom (Fungi), Basidiomycotan, Agaricomycetes, Agaricales,

3.2 Extraneous matters

Foreign matter other than King Oyster Mushroom.

Note. Foreign matter generally includes harmful substances such as planting materials,

insect bodies, hair, plastic, metal, glass, sand and gravel, and animal excrement.
