3.1 permanent exhibition

Exhibitions that last more than one year.

3.2 temporary exhibition

Exhibitions lasting less than one year (inclusive).

Note. It has the characteristics of clear theme, flexible layout, easy assembly and disassembly, and can be reused.

3.3 Exhibits

With the purpose of popularizing science, it uses certain technical means to show the mutual understanding of scientific concepts, scientific principles, scientific methods, etc.

Dynamic devices, technological objects, etc.

3.4 interactive exhibits

It can provide the public with sensory (visual, tactile, olfactory, auditory, balance, etc.) and physical experience conditions, and make decisions on the public's participation behavior. Responding exhibits.

Note. Static exhibits (models, collections, etc.), automatically repeated demonstration exhibits, and multimedia exhibits that play the same content after a single trigger are not considered interactive exhibits.

3.5 special effects theater specialeffecttheater

A cinema used for showing special effects films such as dome screens, giant screens, circular screens, 3D, 4D, dynamic, etc., or for astronomical demonstrations.

3.6 assessmentobject

Science and technology museums under evaluation.

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
