- Part 2: Business Platform Requirements. The purpose is to standardize the technical requirements of the business platform during the digitalization process of logistics enterprises.
- Part 3: Data management requirements. The purpose is to standardize the data management technical requirements during the digitalization process of logistics

enterprises.

- Part 4: Process Optimization Requirements. The purpose is to standardize the business process optimization requirements during the digitalization process of logistics enterprises.

1 Scope

This document establishes the general principles of digitalization of logistics enterprises, and stipulates the digitalization strategy, digitalization technology and digitalization management of logistics enterprises. Require.
