Emergency response plans are a comprehensive application and important vehicle for

emergency management systems, mechanisms, and laws, playing a role in guiding emergency preparedness during peacetime and providing guidance during disasters. The fundamental role of emergency rescue. (Based on the "Emergency Response Law of the People's Republic of China," the "National General Emergency Response Plan," and the "Emergency Response Law") The "Emergency Response Plan Management Measures" and other laws, regulations, and policy documents in the field of emergency management have clarified the basic structure and content of the emergency response plan system. To guide the development of emergency response plans and improve the emergency response plan system, the Emergency Management Bureau of the Ministry of Emergency Management of the People's Republic of China... The organization has developed a series of standards, including GB/T 46793, "Guidelines for the Preparation of Emergency Response Plans for Sudden Incidents." GB/T 46793 aims to clarify the requirements of emergency response plans. The development process and content of emergency plans should be improved to address issues such as the lack of effectiveness in the content, the lack of scientific methodology in the development of emergency plans, and the ineffective activation and response of emergency plans at all levels and types. Addressing prominent issues such as inconsistent implementation, we must comprehensively improve the quality of contingency plans and enhance the coordination and systematic nature of the plan system. According to the classification of emergency response plans in the "Emergency Response Plan Management Measures", GB/T 46793 is proposed to consist of 8 parts.

1 Scope

GB/T 46793.1-2025 is the Chinese national standard covering how an emergency plan is written - the risk assessment behind it, the command structure and who declares what, the resources and their mobilisation, the communication, and the exercises and revisions that keep the document alive. Part 1 of the series, first edition, with Part 2 on township level. Issued on 2 December 2025, it has been in force since 1 July 2026.

This document establishes the principles for developing emergency response plans for sudden incidents, and stipulates the classification, development process, and content of emergency response plans. This document applies to the preparation of emergency response plans for sudden incidents by governments, their departments, units, and grassroots organizations.

3.1 emergency Natural disasters and accidents that occur suddenly and cause or may cause serious social harm, requiring emergency response measures. Difficulties, public health emergencies, and social security incidents.

3.2 A plan developed in advance to minimize the impact of potential emergencies and their consequences.

3.3 Risk assessment Identify potential hazards, analyze the direct, secondary, and derivative consequences of the emergency, and assess the various consequences. The entire process of the degree of harm and the scope of impact.

3.4 Investigate the status of emergency resources available to this region and unit, including emergency forces, supplies, equipment, and facilities, and identify areas within the cooperation region where requests can be made. The status of emergency resources for aid.
