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1 Scope

GB/T 46914-2025 is the Chinese national standard covering the daily care a resident receives - washing, dressing, feeding, toileting and mobility assistance, the assessment that decides how much of each, the dignity and privacy required and the recording of what was actually done. First edition, with the infection control and restraint standards of the same batch, and the mandatory GB 48013-2026 above them all. It was issued on 31 December 2025 and has been in force since 1 April 2026, as a first edition. The document is under the responsibility of the Ministry of Civil Affairs. 3.2 Relevant third party The spouses and guardians of the elderly, as well as individuals or organizations that provide financial guarantees or entrust agents for the elderly. [Source: GB 38600-2019, 3.1]

4.1 Service Providers

4.1.1 Elderly care institutions should formulate systems for the management of daily care services, safety and emergency management, and arrange service personnel to be on duty 24 hours a day.

4.1.2 Elderly care institutions should provide relatively fixed caregivers for the elderly, and the ratio of caregivers to staff should comply with MZ/T 187. Relevant requirements.
