3 Terms and Definitions

GB/T 22117, GB/T 22120, GB/T 39441, GB/T 39444, GB/T 41195, GB/T 42337, GB/T 43697 The following terms and definitions apply to this document.

3.1 Administrative organs, judicial organs, and enterprises, public institutions, and social organizations that lawfully exercise public management (service) functions in the performance of their statutory duties Corporate credit information generated and obtained in the process of providing public services.

3.2 The process of acquiring, processing, analyzing, and utilizing corporate public credit information.

4 Basic Principles

4.1 Compliance Conduct activities related to the application of corporate public credit information in accordance with laws and regulations, and refrain from illegally collecting,

storing, or using information, or infringing upon the commercial rights of enterprises. Secrets and legitimate rights.

4.2 Effectiveness The enterprise public credit information used in the application comes from reliable data sources, ensuring the authenticity, accuracy, timeliness, and reliability of the data.

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
