These documents require that toys be used in a manner intended for their intended use (normal use) and used in a manner unintended for their intended use (foreseeable reasonable misuse). The potential dangers caused. GB (GB/T) 6675 "Toy Safety" is divided into basic specifications, general requirements, and specific requirements, and is proposed to consist of the following parts.

1. Basic Standards. The purpose is to standardize the basic safety requirements for toy products.
2. Mechanical and Physical Properties. The purpose is to standardize the general requirements for the mechanical and physical properties of toy products.
3. Flammability. The purpose is to standardize the general requirements for the flammability of toy products.

1 Scope

GB/T 6675.10-2025 is the Chinese national standard covering the toys a child is meant to smell, wear or taste - the fragrances and the allergens excluded, the cosmetic ingredients and their limits on young skin, the food-grade requirements for the tasting kits, the packaging and the age marking. Part 10 of the toy safety series, first edition. In force from 1 November 2026. Issued on 5 October 2025, it takes effect on 1 November 2026.

This document specifies the technical requirements, equipment, and warnings for olfactory play toys, cosmetic sets, taste play toys, and their supplementary sets. Includes labeling, instructions for use, a list of contents, and first aid information. This document applies to olfactory play toys, cosmetic play sets, taste play toys, and their supplementary sets. This document does not apply to toys and cosmetics.

3 Terms and Definitions

The following terms and definitions apply to this document.

3.1 Olfactoryboard game toy Toys designed to help children learn to identify different smells and fragrances.

Note. Olfactory board play toys include olfactory identification and/or tasting, because tasting is ultimately accomplished through the sense of smell to identify odors and fragrances.

3.2 Cosmetic Kit To help children learn how to make things such as perfumes, soaps, face creams, shampoos, bath gels, lip glosses, lipsticks or other cosmetics, toothpaste, and hair conditioners. Toys intended for use in the production of materials, etc.

3.3 Gustative game toys Toys designed to make candy or dishes using food ingredients such as candy, liquids, powders, and spices.

Note. Taste-themed play toys are also known as taste-themed play sets and food-making play sets.

3.4 Supplementary set Sets intended to be used with matching sets of olfactory play toys, cosmetic play toys, or gustatory play toys.

3.5 Packaging An accessory included with a toy, but not for play. [Source: GB 6675.1-2025, 3.16]
